## 2023-2024 Uniforms/Dress Code Requirements Grades K-8

Uniforms are to be purchased at Dennis School Uniforms located at 5225 West Broward Boulevard in Plantation (954-581-1761). Other than PE clothes all uniforms (including shorts, pants and skirts) must be purchased at Dennis School Uniforms. Jackets with school logo for cooler weather must also be purchased at Dennis Uniforms.

**Students are to wear white crew, athletic or ankle style socks that are visible at all times.**  
**Athletic shoes are to be worn at all times. There are no color restrictions.**  
**No sandals, no open toed shoes, no backless shoes (Crocs), no boots, no dress shoes or flat shoes, no elevated or skate shoes, no shoes with lights are permitted at any time. Belts are navy, black or brown.**

**On Wednesdays, all students wear "Chapel Uniforms."**

**Grades K-5:** For boys, this includes the uniform shorts or pants, a uniform oxford shirt, and a chapel tie. Girls wear uniform shorts, pants, or skirts, a chapel uniform shirt, and their chapel tie.

**NEW THIS YEAR FOR MIDDLE SCHOOL – grades 6-8:** Boys are to wear uniform pants, a uniform oxford shirt, and a chapel tie. Girls are to wear uniform skirt, a uniform oxford shirt, and a chapel tie.

For special programs, chapel may move to a day of the week other than Wednesday; in such cases, families will be notified in advance.

**Other student dress rules:**

1. Hair should be neat, clean and of a natural color **and styled in a way that is not disruptive or draws undue attention.**
2. Girls skirts and dresses must be fingertip length or longer.
3. Girls in grades 6-8 may wear makeup that is tasteful and natural in appearance. Makeup for girls in grades kindergarten through grade 5 is not permitted.
4. Earrings may be worn if they are stud and post. Earrings that dangle are unacceptable.
5. No big jewelry or chains are to be worn.
6. Sweatshirts or jackets with the school logo may be worn in the classroom. Other outerwear, including hats, may only be worn to and from school and outside recess.
7. Shirts must be tucked in at all times.
8. Shorts and/or pants that have belt loops must have a belt.
9. Proper undergarments must be worn at all times and must not be visible.
10. All shorts and pants must be worn at the waist.
11. Shoes with laces must be tied.
12. The administration reserves the right to determine what constitutes proper dress and appearance, and all decisions are final.
13. Specific situations not covered in these guidelines will be reviewed on a case by case basis by the administration.

Upon a dress code violation, the parent will receive a dress code referral form outlining the problem area. Upon the second violation, the student will be detained in the office until appropriate wear is brought to school to remedy the situation. Third violation will require a parent meeting with the principal.

All students are required to have the school's P.E. uniform. The uniform is a monogrammed T-shirt, green gym shorts. (t-shirts and shorts) are available in the school office for purchase. Students must wear athletic shoes and socks with the P.E. uniforms. Students come to school dressed in P.E. uniforms on their scheduled P.E. days. **P.E. shorts must touch the top of the knee and be worn at the waist. They must not be altered in any way.**
