## Pastor's Message

Growing up, Saturday mornings were filled with watching cartoons and then WWF (World Wrestling Federation). I grew up watching Hulk Hogan, Andre the Giant, Hacksaw Jim Duggin, and so many more. As a kid it was exciting to watch the matches, to see them jump from the top rope, and then watch the true victor prevail. My favorite was watching the match where Hulk Hogan body slammed Andre the Giant. What an amazing feat to accomplish.

Yet, apart from Saturdays as a kid, I have done a lot of wrestling in my own life. How about you? For most adults it can feel like we are constantly wrestling with God over this or over that. The questions of "Why God" often prevail, and at times it feels like such a regular process that in some instances we even forget what we started wrestling about.

Unlike Hulk Hogan and Andre the Giant, this morning we hear about Jacob who did not wrestle for entertainment, but because God had a plan for him. Many times, that is what we forget. When God wrestles with us, it is usually because He has a plan that we are ignoring, missing, or fighting against. Maybe, instead of wrestling, we should stop and ask, "God what are You trying to teach me, because right now I feel like I just got body slammed by Hulk Hogan."

During these times, we need to stop, reflect on what is happening, and then turn it back to God. When we struggle, question, fear, doubt, etc. instead of letting that beat us up, just pause and say, "Dear God, right now I feel like I am in a royal rumble, a massive wrestling match with \_\_\_\_\_\_, please help me Dear Father to

understand if there is something that I am missing, and open my heart to understand. Strengthen me Lord, and be with me, so that in all things, I feel Your presence, love, and direction. In Jesus Name. Amen." Then go forth in His grace.
