2026-2027 Uniforms/Dress Code Requirements Grades K-8

Uniforms must be purchased at Flynn O'Hara, located at 3740 Davie Road in Davie (954-233-6523). Except for PE clothes, all School Uniforms, including jackets with the school logo for cooler weather, must also be purchased at Flynn O'Hara.

Athletic shoes are to be worn. There are no color restrictions. Socks of any color are permitted, provided they do not display offensive language, images, or designs. No sandals, open-toed shoes, backless shoes (such as Crocs), boots, dress shoes, flat shoes, elevated or skate shoes, or shoes with lights are permitted at any time. Belts must be navy, black, or brown.

On Wednesdays, all students wear "Chapel Uniforms."

Boys: Can wear uniform shorts or pants and a **red** polo uniform or performance shirt.

Girls: Can wear uniform shorts, pants, or skirts, and a **red** polo uniform or performance shirt.

- Pants, shorts, and skirts are navy or khaki
- Skirts are plaid
- Monogrammed polo shirts are white, baby blue, navy blue, or red
- Monogrammed jackets are navy

For special programs, Chapel may be held on a day other than Wednesday; in such cases, families will be notified in advance.

Other dress rules:

1. Hair should be neat, clean, natural in color, and styled in a way that is not disruptive or draws undue attention.
2. Girls' skirts and shorts must be fingertip length or longer.
3. Girls are not allowed to wear makeup. Grades 6-8 may wear only clear lip gloss.
4. Earrings may be worn if they are studs, posts, or small hoops. Dangle earrings are not allowed. Boys are not permitted to wear earrings.
5. No big jewelry or chains are to be worn.
6. Acrylic nails are not permitted
7. Fake eyelashes are not permitted.
8. Fingernail polish is not permitted, except for natural or clear colors.
9. Only Sweatshirts or jackets with the school logo are permitted for wear in the classroom.
10. Shirts must always be tucked in.
11. Shorts and/or pants that have belt loops must have a belt.
12. Proper undergarments must always be worn and must not be visible.
13. All shorts and pants must be worn at the waist.
14. Shoes with laces must be tied.

The administration reserves the right to establish dress and appearance standards. All decisions are final. The administration will review specific situations not covered in these guidelines on a case-by-case basis.

After a dress code violation, the parent will receive a dress code referral form detailing the specific concern. On the second violation, the student may be held in the office until an appropriate uniform is brought to school to fix the issue. The third violation will require a parent meeting with the principal.

All students are required to wear the school's P.E. uniform. The uniform consists of a monogrammed T-shirt and either green gym shorts or forest green sweatpants. (T-shirts and shorts can be purchased at the school office.) Students are required to wear athletic shoes and socks with the P.E. uniform. On their scheduled P.E. days, students should come to school dressed in the P.E. uniform. P.E. shorts must reach the top of the knee and be worn at the waist. They must not be altered in any way.
